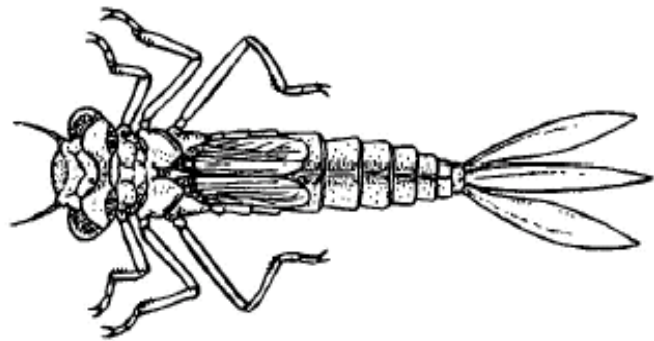


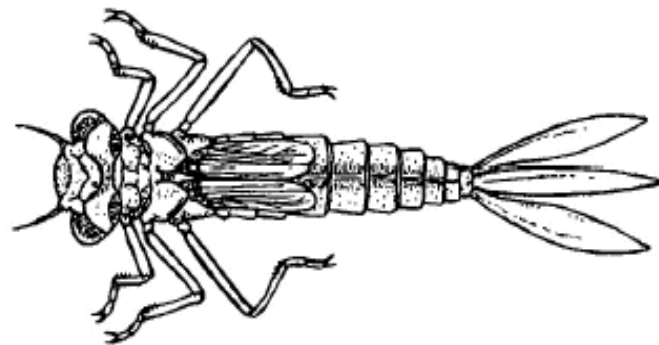
## **Damselfly Nymph**
